The Chairperson initiated the meeting of Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC) with a welcome note to all of the members present. The Chairperson presented the various agendas such as "Discussion on the role of extracurricular activities in prevent ragging" and "Evaluation of counselling services available for ragging victims" along with suggestions and invited the all to clarify the topics and discussion began. The agenda points were discussed and subsequent resolutions were made.

#### Minutes and Resolutions:

- The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and approved with no amendments.
- It was discussed that engaging students in various extracurricular activities can create a monitorial student, reducing instances of ragging.
- Suggestions included organizing inter-departmental sports events, cultural fests, and hobby clubs to foster camaraderie among students. No reports related to ragging were received
- The committee reviewed the campaigns from the last semester, noting their positive impact but also recognizing gaps in reaching all students.
- Feedback indicated a need for more interactive sessions and workshops rather than just seminars.
- A proposal to include a mandatory anti-ragging module in the orientation program for new students was also discussed.
- Members discussed
- The committee discussed the importance of providing adequate support to ragging victims, emphasizing the need for effective counselling services.
- It was noted that while counselling services are available, there is a lack of awareness
  among students about how to access them.



- The committee also identified that there is no formal evaluation process in place to assess the effectiveness of these services.
- The chairperson concluded the activity "Discussion on the role of extracurricular activities in prevent ragging" and a meeting on "Evaluation of counselling services available for ragging victims"
- The tentative dates were finalised for "Discussion on the role of extracurricular activities in prevent ragging" on 10.02.2025 and a meeting on "Evaluation of counselling services available for ragging victims" on 16.04.2025.
- The meeting was ended with Vote of Thanks at 01:32PM.
- It is resolved that the newly formed Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC) will organize a discussion on implement a range of extracurricular activities aimed at fostering an inclusive and friendly campus environment to prevent ragging and integrate these activities into the college's annual calendar and encourage student participation through incentives and organize a committee meeting to undertake an evaluation of the counselling services available to ragging victims.

- Members agreed to include topics such as legal consequences of ragging, psychological impact on victims, and ways to report incidents.
- It was decided that the workshop would include interactive sessions and role-playing activities to engage students.
- The chairperson concluded the committee formation and mentioned the role of allotted members and a workshop conducted on Anti-Ragging Awareness for freshers.
- The tentative dates were finalised for an Anti-Ragging Awareness workshop on 18.11.2024.
- The meeting was ended with Vote of Thanks at 12:07PM.



• It is resolved that the newly formed Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC) will have the authority to investigate any reported cases of ragging within the college premises and will organize an Anti-Ragging Awareness Workshop for the new batch of students to educate students about the serious consequences of ragging, both legally and psychologically, and to provide them with information on how to report any incidents.
